

SCHEME OF WORK EMERGENCY AID FOR APPOINTED PERSONS

Student Objectives

- Life threatening priorities – which injuries to treat first – ABC's

- 1 person CPR
- What to do if mouth to mouth ventilation cannot be achieved – poor technique, stoma, blockage etc.
- Casualty handling – prone to supine and action for vomiting
- Choking
- Shock – including anaphylactic shock
- Angina and heart attack
- Recognise the use of dressings and bandages
